Date: Sunday June 27, 2010

Location: Burlingame, CA – Start/Finish at intersection of Burlingame and Lorton Avenues.

Directions: South from San Francisco (or north from San Jose) on Hwy 101 take the Broadway/Burlingame exit west. At the third light turn left onto California Drive and watch for the parking signs after 1 mile, near the Burlingame Caltrain station.

Race Parking: Please follow the signs on California Drive and park only in the designated area which is the Cal Train parking lot. **DO NOT PARK ON CHAPIN LANE.** This is an important stipulation for our event permit.
